From mid-June to mid-September, the local arts scene comes to life with a variety of festivals and tours. If you want to discover Townships talent, there's no better time to visit.

[Circuit des Arts Memphrémagog](#) shines a spotlight on the region through the plethora of artists that live and work here. Ever wanted to visit a working artist's workshop? This is your chance! Otherwise, [Festival des Arts Georgeville-Fitch Bay](#) brings together several artists and artisans to welcome art lovers in a unique celebration of talent and creativity.

[Tour des Arts](#) and [La Tournée des 20](#) are two popular art tours. Visitors travel around the region to visit artists in their workshops, giving them an up-close-and-personal look at the creative process—not to mention delightful conversations about their craft, accomplishments, and passion. For a truly unique event, don't miss [CeraMystic](#) in Saint-Ignace-de-Stanbridge. For ten days, you can admire the work of thirty ceramic workers—including some of the top artists in the province.

Of course, there are museums and cultural centres open year-round with permanent exhibits, including the [Musée des Beaux-Arts de Sherbrooke](#) that showcases the work of local artists, the [Centre Culturel Yvonne L. Bombardier](#), a rich cultural spot for liberal and visual arts in Valcourt, as well as the [Uplands Cultural and Heritage Centre](#) in Lennoxville.
